

PCW9512 Information

The PCW9512 is a complete word processor including Daisywheel printer and LocoScript 2 word processing software designed to produce high quality documents ranging from simple letters to complete books.

Operating the PCW9512 is very straightforward because of the on-screen help and menus of LocoScript 2. The User Guide deals with all aspects of word processing. It is highly recommended that you study the User Guide.

The two following pages are designed to demonstrate some of the features and facilities of the PCW9512.

This demonstration page shows some of the range and style of characters available in **LocoScript 2**, together with a few examples of page layout. There are powerful facilities for multi-page documents, and a comprehensive selection of headers and footers plus options for page-breaks are available.

- a) The screen editor is controlled by dedicated keys, while emphasis and style can either be selected from function-key operated pull-down menus, or typed in directly by the more experienced user. The heart of the system is the Disc Management screen which shows the diskette contents at a glance and can invoke document creation or editing in two simple keystrokes.
- b) Proportional spacing, centring and justification (on-screen for non-ps pitches) are fully supported, irrespective of **pitch changes**. Ruler layouts can be inserted in the text to change margins and tabs. Format codes and ruler layouts may be displayed, or invisible, as the user requires. Cut and Paste with Phrase-Store memories permit rapid editing of large sections of the document.

A special feature is the simultaneous availability of £ and #).

LocoScript has been specially designed to allow internationalised versions (with customised keyboards), whilst every version allows the entry all characters. Different countries are supplied with a print wheel specially tailored for their national requirements.

Perfect letter quality printing is obtained from the built-in printer, which can handle single sheet or continuous paper, as well as permitting simultaneous editing and printing.
